POLICY #: 506 INDOOR AIR QUALITY

POLICY: Central Valley Health District (CVHD) will assist the public in identifying and mitigating indoor air quality concerns.

PROCEDURE:

1. All mold calls should be referred to an Environmental Health Practitioner for proper technical advice and direction. Requests for mold testing and identification should be referred to the private companies that conduct the types of services.
 - a. Log all complaints/questions on to CVHD complaint log under Environmental Health on the CVHD shared drive.
2. Those persons concerned about mold may also have a sample tested at NDSU. To submit a sample, contact the NDSU Plant Diagnostician at 701-231-7854.
3. Handouts are available from the North Dakota Department of Health and may be utilized for mold inquiries.
4. Other indoor air quality concerns may include radon and asbestos. Provide advice, handouts, and make radon test kits available.
